The successful candidate will demonstrate a commitment to Christ and practice an Anabaptist faith alongside the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in religious studies, Christian education, social services, or related field
- Previous experience either vocationally or as a volunteer working with children, youth, and young adults
- Ability to model a passion and curiosity for spiritual practices and to engage children, youth, and young adults in a personal and meaningful way
- High degree of self-awareness, social intelligence, and maturity
- Highly effective communication, listening, and interpersonal skills
- Sensitive to diversity (e.g. gender and sexual identities, race, varied church experiences and walks of life, etc.)
- Willingness to take courses, participate in retreats, and spiritual direction to enhance knowledge and skills in Christian formation
- Awareness and practice of safe and appropriate boundaries within all relationships according to BMC safety policies and MCEC Sacred Trust booklet
- Clean vulnerable sector police check
